


Course Outline for Qira-aat (Qura'nic Scripture Sciences)

Study the method of using annotation in the Holy Quran

Identify the various methods of recitation by annotating them in the Holy Quran

Study of the terms and abbreviations used to annotate

Audio

Study and listen to various readers and identify techniques of pronunciation
