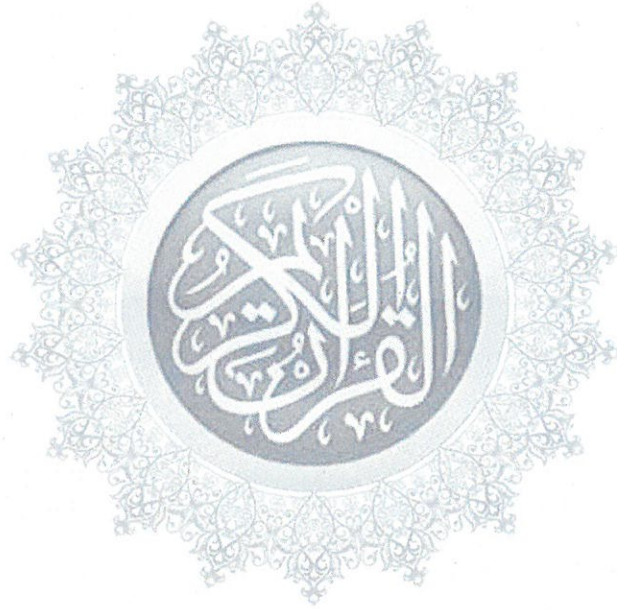

LOG BOOK

The Hifdh Log Book plays an integral part in helping one to progress. Furthermore, it will help to measure improvements and help tailor Hifdh targets according to one's ability. It is also an excellent communication tool between the teacher, student and parent. This Log Book will record the following:

- **Juz completion record** – includes the duration of time taken to complete the Juz
- **Daily progress** of Sabaq/Sabaq Para and Dor
- **End of Juz test report** – includes feedback of recitation and potential areas of improvement
- **Target Section** – allows for the teacher and student to negotiate targets
- **Complaints record**
- **Islamic studies Record**

Parents are required to:

- Ensure your child is sitting down to learn / revise every day at the appointed times. Supervision may be required at times.
- Check daily progress and sign the Hifdh Log every day.
- Make comments in the relevant section provided regarding any concerns you may have.
- Read the End of Juz test report so that any improvements suggested by the examiner can be discussed and implemented.
- Sympathise with your child in their moments of struggle and difficulty.
- Make consistent dua for the success of your child in this blessed endeavour and to also encourage them to supplicate to the Almighty daily.
