

HADITH SPECIALISATION COURSE (1 YEAR COURSE)

Duration and timings of the course: The course is designed to be delivered as a one year intensive study programme. The taught modules will be delivered daily from Monday to Friday during the evening (5pm to 8pm). There will also be an additional lesson on Saturday afternoons (11am to 2pm). Along with these class hours, students will be doing guided individual reading and assignment work during the day.

Term dates and fees: The term dates and fees (both for residential & non-residential students) will be the same as the normal full-time Jamiah term dates and fees. Please refer to the website for the updated term dates.

Curriculum: The following subjects and modules will be amongst those covered:

- Authority of Sunnah,
- The history and development of Hadeeth and related sciences,
- Introduction to Usool Hadeeth,
- Takhrij of Hadeeth,
- Tadreeb Rawi/Muqaddimah Ibn Salah,
- Chapters of Sunnah from Hanafi usool works,
- *Ilm of jarh and ta'deel,*
- *Ilm of rijaal,*
- Manuscript reading and editing,
- Memorisation of Hadeeth.

Assessment: As well as examinations, students will be expected to complete several pieces of assignments ranging from simple questions and tasks to written essays and presentations. They will be designed to assess a students progress and achievements on the different modules within the syllabus.

What are students expected to do during the non-teaching hours? Students will be given many assignments which would include written assignments, reading, presentations etc. They will complete these tasks during the day (using the resources available).
